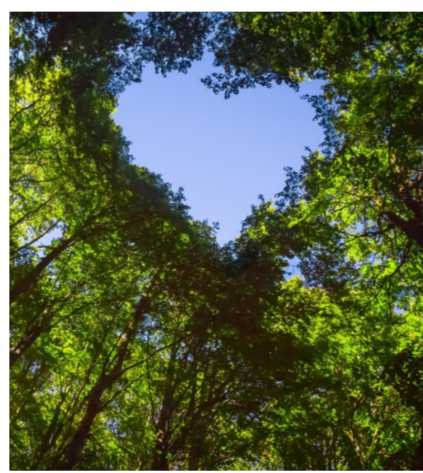


Get To Know Our Natives by Nature

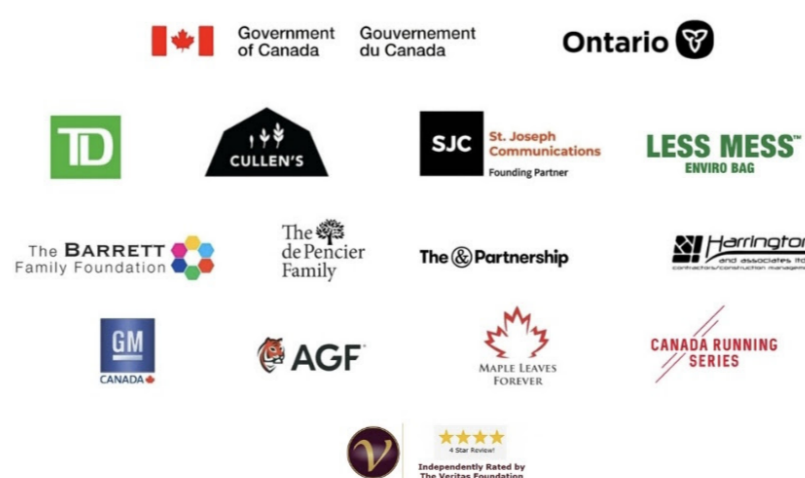
